PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Well, I looked back at my report from week 3 and what a difference 3 days make! Non -operational for a day and a bit and then several families going into self isolation for 14 days!! Theoretically, most of us will be back on Monday 8th. Some people are caught up with close and casual contacts from outside of the school, and we will welcome them back when they have "done their time".



As you would have read in my letter to parents /carers on Nov 3rd, we have had some restrictions relaxed on our school status. These were outlined in the letter. You can view that letter via the link below:

We will continue to operate in two "cohorts" K- 2 and 3-6.

Morning drop off will remain as normal at the front gate. They will then move from the gate to: K-2 - the Hall COLA area, 3-6 The main COLA area.

Pick up time will remain as aphabetically staggered as listed below.

- 2.30pm Surnames beginning with A-F
- 2.40pm Surnames beginning with G-O
- 2.50pm Surnames beginning with P-Z

Please bring your name card!!!

Due to the time constraints of staggered afternoon pick ups, and severe restrictions on parents attending, we will not be having weekly assemblies. We will continue to handout our class awards in class and publish the recipients in the school newsletter.

Students are <u>expected to attend school</u> unless they are unwell or have even with mild symptoms of COVID-19. Any person with any COVID-19 symptoms must be sent home and not return to school unless:

- they have isolated for 10 days, when no medical certificate is available
- they have a negative COVID-19 test result and are symptom free.

In circumstances where children have other medical reasons for recurrent symptoms, a letter from their GP is sufficient to negate the requirement for a negative test.

Anyone who is unwell with COVID-19 symptoms is strongly encouraged to get tested and self-isolate until a negative result is received.

Students not attending school (without Public Health order restrictions) will **NOT** be supported by "Learning from Home" structures and online feedback from MEPS staff.

Facemasks

The wearing of facemasks by students is strongly recommended inside rooms at MEPS for Primary aged children. We have child size masks at the school; However, if you do not wish your child to wear a facemask please contact the school or drop me a line via my email listed below.

NAPLAN results

2021 Individual student NAPLAN results (Years 3 & 5) were handed out to students last week to take home. If you wish to have further explanation of the results, please contact your child's teacher. I will be presenting some bulk school base data in upcoming newsletters.

This week, you will see below three different graphs, our performance against the targets we set to achieve this year in our School Improvement Plan, and also performance against the targets we set in the expected growth of results between years 3 (2019) and 5 (2021). Our Reading results have shown us to exceed our targets, whereas our Numeracy results are within our upper and lower limits set. We are currently have Mrs Horgan participating in the NSW DoE "Primary Mathematics Specialist Teacher Initiative" as part of our school's approach to work on specific teaching and learning strategies in mathematics so as to work on further improving student achievement in mathematics.

School Annual Presentation Assemblies - Wednesday 8th December

Based on current restrictions, we will need to run two outdoor sessions a K-2 session and a 3-6 session. The 3-6 Assembly will run from 9.30am - 11.00am, and the K-2 Assembly will run from 12.30pm-2.00pm. We are currently sending revised invitations to our VIPs. 






















NAPLAN 2021 OVERALL SCHOOL RESULTS
